

### Researchers/academic institutions:

In the project eBADGE, the research partners, focuses on the analysis of the differences in the regulatory framework among the analysed countries, the appraisal of the existing barriers and harmonization needs for a common pan-European cross-border balancing market in these countries and the development of scenarios for the simulation of such a market. Besides that also the impacts of such a balancing market on the distribution networks and the interaction of market driven and network driven approaches for future network operation, including the related ICT requirements are analysed by partners like AIT (Austrian Institute of Technology). Other research institutions could enhance their knowledge of the analysed topics stated above. Moreover, they also have the opportunity to work together with the research partners in eBADGE in joint research collaborations and to publish scientific work in electrical engineering journals and in relevant conferences.
